The Petitioner(s) Agree to:

To accept responsibility to acquire all easements from property owners through which the drain runs to the point of discharge.

It is understood that in the event of heavy rains/snow melt or the ditch becomes adversely impacted by the dewatering, the Drainage Board may require the Petitioner to cease to discharge until the system can handle the flow. The discharge point shall be stabilized to protect the banks and channel at the outlet site. The Surveyor's office shall be advised when the dewatering commences and concludes so it can be monitored for any impacts to the ditch and evaluate any erosion concerns. If erosion has occurred, the Petitioner will be required to repair any erosion at the discharge point and remove any sediment deposits from the channel caused by the dewatering process.

It is agreed to restore the land, drainage ditches and other surface to as good a condition as they were at the commencement of the work, including backfilling of any trenches opened, and maintaining the surface which has been disturbed by the changes for a period of six (6) months after completion of said work.

And further, the petitioner(s) shall and will, indemnify and save the County harmless from and against any and all damages, injuries, losses, claims, demands or costs proximately caused by the fault, culpability or negligence of the Petitioner(s) by any work instigated by the Petitioner(s).

In the granting of this Permit by the Elkhart County Drainage Board or the Elkhart County Surveyor's Office does not in any way relieve the petitioner of the necessity of securing easements or other property rights, permits and approvals from affected property owners and other local, state, and federal agencies.

The undersigned Petitioner(s) affirms that the information, data and copies herewith transmitted are true and accurate to the best of the knowledge and belief of the Petitioner(s).
